ORDINANCE NO. 420

AN ORDERANCE RELATING TO DOGS WITHIN THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE

Whereas, on February 15, 1986, the City enacted Ordinance No. 109 relating to dogs, and on December 04, 1990 enacted Ordinance No.126, related to pit bulls, within the City of Taylorsville, and

Whereas the Kentucky General Assembly has since revised Chapter 258, titled Animal Control and Protection, which relates to dogs, and

Whereas, KRS 258.195(1) requires counties to have an animal control officer to enforce all laws relating to dogs within a county, and

Whereas, at a City meeting held on December 14, 2021, the Spencer County Animal Control Officer advised the City, the Spencer County Control Officer will enforce the provisions of Chapter 258 and local County animal control ordinances, within the City of Taylorsville,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE as follows:

- 1.) Ordinance No.109, relating to dogs within the City, is HEREBY REPEALED;
- 2.) Ordinances No. 126, relating to pit bulls within the City, is HEREBY REPEALED;
- 3.) Any other Ordinance which the City may have enacted related to dogs within the City, is **HEREBY REPEALED**;
- 4.) The City incorporates by reference, the provision of Chapter 258 and any county ordinances as may relate to animal control, particularly as to dogs within the City of Taylorsville and, which shall be enforce by the Spencer County Animal Control Officer.

This Ordinance shall be come effect upon its enactment and its publication.
