SUMMARY OF CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 385

Mayor, City of Taylorsville, KY

Published: 6-20-2018

This is a summary of Ordinance No. 385, amending Ordinance No. 378, establishing new water rates for all water customers and sewer rates for customers located on USA property etc. effective July 1, 2018.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville operates a water distribution system and receives treated water from the Louisville Water Company, and,

WHEREAS, the Louisville Water Company is raising its wholesale water rates to its wholesale customers, such as the City of Taylorsville, and due to said increase by LWC and due to increase in other costs to the City in operating the water system, and

WHEREAS, the City also operates, a wastewater treatment and collection system to which the City is now collection wastewater discharge from customers on property owned by the United States of America and managed by the Army Corps of Engineers,

Therefore, the City amends Ordinance No. 378, to establish new water rates for all water customers and to establish sewer rates for the customers on the USA property, as
