**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING MONTHLY MEDICAL BENEFITS PAYMENTS
TO THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSIONERS**

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville enacted Ordinance No. 263 on April 5th, 2005 to provide
medical benefits, for the Mayor and the City Commissioners, and,

WHEREAS, KRS 79.080(3) authorizes cities to provide such medical benefits, and,

WHEREAS, the City provides medical benefits for its employees, and,

WHEREAS, changes have occurred in the tax laws and the increase in medical costs, since 2005 and,

WHEREAS, due to those changes, the City deems it in the best interest of the City to repeal
Ordinance 263, which the City has repealed by Ordinance No. 388 effective January 1, 2019 and,

WHEREAS, the City deems it in the City's best interest to provide medical benefit payments to the
City's elected officials, the Mayor and the City Commissioners, in conformity with the new tax laws and with the
increase in medical costs;
