**AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES BY THE DRINK IN CERTAIN HOTELS,
MOTELS, INNS AND RESTAURANTS, PURSUANT TO
KRS 243.072.**


WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville, a Fourth Class City, has enacted Ordinance No. 348 regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages and otherwise providing for alcoholic beverage control within the City of Taylorsville, Spencer County, Kentucky, and,

WHEREAS, KRS 243.072(2), authorizes a Fourth Class City to enact an Ordinance regulating the licenses of certain hotels, motels, inns and restaurants, to allow the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink in those hotels, motels, inns and restaurants, if the Legislative body determines that an economic hardship exists within the City and the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink could aid economic growth, and,

WHEREAS, the City herein determines there is an economic hardship in the City and the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink could aid in economic growth.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Taylorsville, pursuant to KRS 243.072, the City has determined an economic hardship exists within the City of Taylorsville and that the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink could aid in the economic growth of the City, does herein enact this Ordinance authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink for consumption on the premises in certain hotels, motels, inns and restaurants, within the City of Taylorsville and for the issuance of the appropriate license and fees, including regulatory fees as authorized by laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky in regard to alcoholic beverages and further herein incorporates by reference Ordinance No. 348, which established an alcoholic beverage administrator and for the regulation of the sale of alcoholic beverages within the City of Taylorsville.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

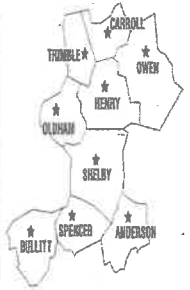
