

ORDINANCE NO. 456

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VI, SECTION 601.3(D) OF THE
TAYLORSVILLE-SPENCER COUNTY ZONING REGULATIONS REGARDING
CONDITIONAL USES ALLOWED IN THE B-1, NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL
DISTRICT ZONE PERTAINING TO CRAFT DISTILLERY, CLASS B (ONLY)

Upon the recommendation of the Taylorsville-Spencer County Joint Planning and Zoning Commission, the City of Taylorsville enacted City Ord. No. 456, summarized herein.

Article VI, Provisions Governing B-1 Neighborhood Commercial Districts, Section 601.3(D) is added to the 2014 Taylorsville-Spencer County Zoning Regulations, and allows a "Craft Distillery, Class B (only)" as a conditional use in such District.

Article VI Sect. 601.3(D) Craft Distillery, Class B only

The ordinance establishes a "Craft Distillery, Class B (only)" as a Conditional Use in a B-1 Neighborhood Commercial District; allows for conditions of operation to be imposed by the Board of Adjustments; sets retail alcohol sales conditions, production and storage maximums; establishes visitor center, tour, food service, complimentary products, tasting room & retail sales requirements; regulates festivals and public gatherings; sets signage limitations; requires roadway analysis, sets loading and unloading and restricts tractor-trailer traffic; requires compliance with fire safety, environmental and health standards; establishes sewer and water, and annual production requirements and inspections; specifies BOA authority over hours of operation, screening, and buffering, among other powers.
