ORDINANCE NO. 459

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VI, SECTION 602.3(E) OF THE TAYLORS VILLE-SPENCER COUNTY ZONING REGULATIONS REGARDING CONDITIONAL USES ALLO WED IN THE B-2, GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT ZONE PERTAINING TO MICRO-BREWERY

Upon the recommendation of the Taylorsville-Spencer County Joint Planning and Zoning Commission, the City of Taylorsville enacted City Ord. No. 458, summarized herein.

Article VI, Provisions Governing B-2 General Commercial Districts, Section 602.3(E) is added to the 2014 Taylorsville-Spencer County Zoning Regulations, and allows a "Micro-Brewery" as a

Article VI Sect. 602.3(E) Micro-Brewery

The ordinance establishes a "Micro-Brewery" as a Conditional Use in a B-2 General Commercial District; allows for conditions of operation to be imposed by the Board of Adjustments; sets retail alcohol sales conditions, production and storage maximums; establishes visitor center, tour, food service, complimentary products, tasting room & retail sales requirements; regulates festivals and public gatherings; sets signage limitations; requires roadway analysis, sets loading and unloading and restricts tractor-trailer traffic; requires compliance with fire safety, environmental and health standards; establishes sewer and water, and annual production requirements and inspections; specifies BOA authority over hours of operation, screening, and
