

CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE  
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
OF THE TAYLORSVILLE CITY COMMISSION  
SEPTEMBER 16, 2025 @ 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Karen Spencer called to order the Special Called meeting of the Taylorsville City Commission at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Spencer then welcomed those in attendance. City Attorney, Robert Myles led the audience in prayer. Roll call of the Commission revealed the following:

Employees present – Marcia Finley, Robert Myles and Stacey Crenshaw.

**Approval of Agenda.** Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the agenda as presented, seconded by Commissioner Spears with all eyes being cast.

**Interlocal Agreement.** City Attorney, Robert Myles read an Interlocal Agreement between Spencer County Sanitation District and The City of Taylorsville regarding delinquent utility invoices and disconnection of water. Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the Interlocal Agreement with amendments made to section (2) allowing the City to amend reconnect and disconnect charges at any time and deleting section (6) that gave the customer a choice to opt out. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Spears with all eyes being cast.

**Memorandum of Understanding.** The Memorandum of Understanding between the Spencer County Fire District and The City of Taylorsville was discussed and since it had already been voted and approved in July, no action was taken.

**Memorandum of Understanding.** City Attorney, Robert Myles, stated the Memorandum of Understanding between Spencer County Fiscal Court, Spencer County Fire District and the Taylorsville Police Department was ready, and he would forward a copy to everyone the following day. Mr. Myles suggested the Commission go ahead and vote on it. Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the Memorandum of Understanding to allow installation of radio equipment on or at the water towers, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all eyes being cast.

**Resolution/Surplus Property (Ford F150).** Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the Resolution for Surplus Property to surplus a Ford F150 truck for the Public Works

Department, and sale at public auction, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all eyes being cast.

**Resolution/Surplus Property (Misc phones and computer equipment).** Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the Resolution for Surplus Property to surplus 4 laptops, 1 docking station, 5 monitors, 8 hard drives, 8 keyboards, 4 mouse, 1 printer, 1 set of computer speakers, 4 receipt printers, 5 Mitel phones, 16 inter-tel phones and 2 chairs for destruction, 2 Apple I-pone 8s, 3 I-phone 11s, and 7 I-phone 14s to return to AT&T for credit. Commissioner Hilbert seconded the motion with all eyes being cast.

**Taylorsville Trail/Sidewalks.** Mayor Spencer mentioned to the Commission that Department of Transportation is asking for more information from Joe Sisler with Sisler-Maggard Engineering such as updated drawings, estimates, utility and rail certifications, bid proposals, and a traffic management plan. This was tabled until the next regular meeting.

**Communication with Commission.** City Attorney Robert Myles says he wants to make sure when he sends things to the Commission that it is done in the appropriate way. Commissioner Spears noted that when she receives an email, she cannot see it on her phone. There was discussion about trying a tablet and/or using the hot spot on the cell phone for a computer.


