

CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OF THE TAYLORSVILLE CITY COMMISSION
JANUARY 27th, 2026 @ 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Karen Spencer called to order the special called meeting of the Taylorsville City Commission at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Spencer welcomed those in attendance followed with a prayer by Commissioner Bell. Roll call of the Commission revealed the following:

Employees present – Marcia Finley, Dave Bollinger, John Harris, Stacey Crenshaw, Keith Waldridge, Cliff Brown and City Attorney Robert Myles.

Agenda. ***Mayor Spencer made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all eyes being cast. Motion carried 4-0.***

Minutes. ***Mayor Spencer made a motion to approve the Minutes from the January 13th meeting as presented, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all eyes being cast. Motion carried 4-0.***

Zoning Change 106 Railroad St. (2ND Reading). Planning and Zoning was not present, tabled until next meeting.

Tourism. Katherine Scott could not be present due to weather conditions. Tabled until next meeting.

Spencer County Schools Co-Op Program. Public Works Director, David Bollinger informed the Commission he has been speaking with Lesley Slaughter with Spencer County School District about a co-op program. The school district will pay the students' wages as reimbursement and currently has enough funding to pay through until the end of June. Bollinger said he would like to have 3 students. ***Mayor Spencer made a motion to enter the co-op program with the Spencer County School District and allow for 3 students, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all eyes being cast. Motion carried 4-0.***

Sanitation Rate Ordinance (2ND Reading). City Attorney, Robert Myles read the second reading of an ordinance establishing a monthly rate of \$20.46 per establishment for the City of Taylorsville. This ordinance also allows for a penalty for any violations. ***Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the Ordinance, seconded by Commissioner Bentley. Roll call vote revealed the following:***

Motion carried with a 5-0 vote.

ABC Administrator Contract. City Clerk Marcia Finley informed the Commission the current contract with the ABC Administrator, Scot Heath has expired. Clerk Finley said she is waiting for the County to send her an updated contract. This was tabled until the next meeting.

BEST Equipment Contracts. **Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the 3 contracts from BEST Equipment for a Combo Truck, a camera system for the combo truck and an Envirosight Verisight Ultra push camera system, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**

Mold Remediation. City Clerk Marcia Finley updated the Commission on some bathroom issues in the Annex building that was found by Best Restoration. The heater box under the women's bathroom sink had been leaking and caused mold in the walls between the restrooms. A new heater box has been ordered for both bathrooms and will be installed as soon as the parts come in.

Clerk Training. City Clerk Marcia Finley asked permission from the Commission to attend the City Clerk's Spring Conference April 15-17th, 2026. **Commissioner Hilbert made a motion to approve Spring Conference for Clerk Finley, seconded by Mayor Spencer with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**

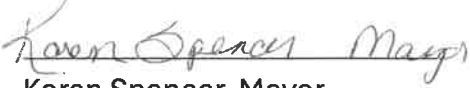
SCADA Computer Upgrade. Public Works Director, Dave Bollinger asked the Commission to approve a quote from Citco Water for a SCADA Computer Upgrade. Bollinger asked for approval for next fiscal year's budget, adding this was a project that was already in the work before he was hired. **Mayor Spencer made a motion to approve the purchase of a new SCADA Computer upgrade to be paid for in the next fiscal year budget in the amount of \$49,355.00, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**

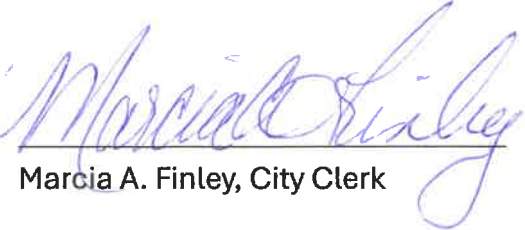
Executive Session. **Mayor Spencer made a motion to go into executive session, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**

Open Session. **Mayor Spencer made a motion to return to open session, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**

Action Taken. **Mayor Spencer made a motion to advertise for Accounts Payable/Human Resources position with an annual pay of \$75,000-80,000, and to hire Chris Vires part-time with an hourly pay of \$30.00 and to remove Scott Williams from driving and operating any city vehicle or equipment until he can provide a current eye exam, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**

Adjournment. This concluding the business of the meeting, **Commissioner Bell made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all eyes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.**
