6. Executive Session - Adjourn to Executive Session Pursuant to KRS 61.815, notice is given for the need for a closed session to discuss the following:

**Discussions of matters which might lead to the appointment or reappointment of specific individual employees to specific positions and/or members and/or the discipline or the dismissal of an employee or member, KRS 61.810 (1)**

**(b) Deliberations on the future acquisition or sale of real property by a public agency, but only when publicity would be likely to affect the value of a specific piece of property to be acquired for public use or sold by a public agency;**

**(c) Discussions of proposed or pending litigation against or on behalf of the public agency;**

**(f) Discussions or hearings which might lead to the appointment, discipline, or dismissal of an individual employee, member, or student without restricting that employee's, member's, or student's right to a public hearing if requested. This exception shall not be interpreted to permit discussion of general personnel matters in secret;**

**(g) Discussions between a public agency and a representative of a business entity and discussions concerning a specific proposal, if open discussions would jeopardize the siting, retention, expansion, or upgrading of the business;\_**

**These matters need to be discussed in closed sessions to protect confidentiality.**

**These matters need to be discussed in executive session to protect attorney client privilege, strategy, and tactics etc.**
