EMERGENCY MEETING
OF THE TAYLORSVILLE CITY COMMISSION
MARCH 3RD, 2026 @ 5:15 P.M.

Mayor Karen Spencer called to order the special called meeting of the Taylorsville City Commission at 5:00 p.m. Roll call of the Commission revealed the following:

Statement of Circumstances. City Attorney, Robert Myles read the statement of circumstances as follows: circumstances giving rise to this emergency meeting revolve around the indictment of a city employee holding a supervisory position and the potential impact of such a daily and ongoing city operations.

Discussion. City Attorney, Robert Myles read a list of charges he said he received from CourtNet and AOC that was brought by the Breckinridge Circuit Court, Division I of an Indictment against the Public Works Director, David Bollinger. The charges are as follows:

COUNT I: That on about or in between October 16, 2024 and May 21, 2025, in Breckinridge County, Kentucky, the Defendant, David A. Bollinger, committed the offense of Fraudulent use of Credit Card \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, when she, with the intent to defraud, intentionally used a credit/debit card belonging to City of Hardinsburg, for the purpose of obtaining money, goods, or services with a value over \$1,000;


COUNT II: That on about or in between October 16, 2024 and May 21, 2025, in Breckinridge County, Kentucky, the Defendant, David A. Bollinger, committed the offense of Tampering with Physical Evidence, when he, believing that an official proceeding is pending or may be instituted he, destroyed, mutilated, concealed, removed, or altered physical evidence, which he believed was about to be produced or used in the official proceeding with intent to impair its verity or availability in the official proceeding;


COUNT III: That on about or in between October 16, 2024 and May 21, 2025, in Breckinridge County, Kentucky, the Defendant, David A. Bollinger, committed the offense of Theft by Unlawful Taking or Disposition of Property all others, when he took property with a value of under \$500, belonging to City of Hardinsburg, with the intent to deprive him thereof;

City Attorney, Robert Myles informed the Commission that the case can go before the Grand Jury and that they need to remember that innocent until proven guilty and the charges are only one side of the story. After a brief discussion, ***Commissioner Hilbert made a motion***

to take all credit card and purchasing powers away from the Public Works Director, Dave Bollinger, until further notice and for the City Clerk, Marcia Finley to notify Jay Smith, Cliff Brown and Keith Waldrige that Keith Waldrige will be in charge on Wednesday, March 4th, during Mr. Bollinger's absence and to have a Special Called Meeting on Thursday, March 5th at 6:00 p.m. to discuss this matter further, seconded by Mayor Spencer with all eyes being cast. Motion Carried 5-0.

Adjournment. This concluding the business of the meeting, Mayor Spencer made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all eyes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.
