SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OF THE TAYLORSVILLE CITY COMMISSION
APRIL 28th, 2026 @ 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Karen Spencer called to order the special called meeting of the Taylorsville City Commission at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Spencer welcomed those in attendance followed with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Dave Bollinger and a prayer by Commissioner Bell. Roll call of the Commission revealed the following:

Agenda. *Mayor Spencer made a motion to accept the agenda as presented, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.*

Minutes. *Mayor Spencer made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Commissioner Bentley with all ayes being cast.*

Chamber/Tourism. Jeff Davis reminded everyone about the upcoming Shakespeare on Main event. Mr. Davis also mentioned the luncheon for First Responders, and they were still in need of sponsors.

Main Street. Kim Elzy read a portion of their meeting minutes from a recent Main Street meeting and mentioned monies that were allotted to them in the amount of \$578,400 that will be appropriated for events on Main. Mayor Spencer asked if the money would go through the city. Front Office Lead Stacey Crenshaw said according to the Main Street By-Laws, the money should go through the city. Terry Vaughn mentioned he had contacted Salt River about moving electric lines on Main Street but has not received a quote.

Contracts Expiring 6/30/2026. City Clerk Marcia Finley reported there are 4 contracts expiring on 6/30/2026. Finley said the cleaning, engineering, Main Street Manager and School Resource Officer contracts are all up for renewal. ***Mayor Spencer made a motion to table until next meeting, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.***

Sewer Rates. Public Works Director, Dave Bollinger, informed the Commission that the current sewer rates are too low and he would like to ask permission to have Sisler Maggard Engineering to do a rate study. ***Commissioner Hilbert made a motion to have Sisler Maggard perform a rate study on the sewer rates, seconded by Commissioner Spears with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.***

Executive Session. Mayor Spencer made a motion to go into executive session according to KRS 61.810, seconded by Commissioner Hilbert with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.

Open Session. Mayor Spencer made a motion to return to open session, seconded by Commissioner Spears with all ayes being cast. Motion carried 5-0.

Action Taken. Mayor Spencer made a motion

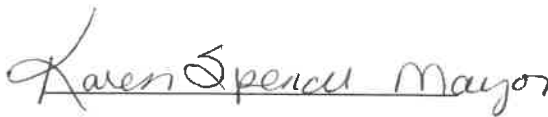
****To update the Facilities Plan required by Division of Water and to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Spencer County Fiscal Court***

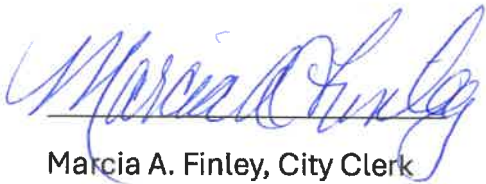
****To have signs made for Settler's Trace that say, "Private Road refer to Ordinance #?"***
